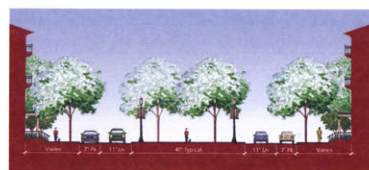

BROADWAY AVENUE
Broadway Avenue is proposed to extend from Ballard Parkway south to Grove Hill Road, creating a ceremonial axial relationship between the existing Temple Terrace Elementary School and other adjacent civic uses to the north with the proposed City Hall, City Hall Plaza, and Cultural Center to the south. Lined with trees, pathways, and benches, a 40-foot wide median creates a central green space (Broadway Greens) that connects to the larger open space network and provides passive recreational amenities.

Proposed five-story multi-family residential development frames the Broadway on the east and west sides. The section above and a perspective rendering below further illustrate the proposed extension of Broadway Avenue.
