The Vlass Group selected for Temple Terrace's downtown project

TEMPLE TERRACE--City leaders voted unanimously Thursday morning to begin negotiations with The Vlass Group in hopes of bringing the city's long-dreamed of downtown redevelopment project to reality.

The council also voted to hire a project manager to fill the gap left behind after the city's redevelopment director, Michael Marshall, quit Monday.

Members of the council said a dual-position is needed - a redevelopment director and project manager.

City leaders also voted to place a Temple Terrace citizen on its Community Redevelopment Agency Committee. Who that citizen will be remains undecided.

However, the council members will provide names to City Manager Kim Leinbach and the council will vote to appoint the person.
