

## TEMPLE TERRACES' NEW NINE HOLES COMPLETES PICTURESQUE AND INTERESTING GOLF COURSE

Two Holes Designed for Famous Ones in Scotland Feature "Out" Half. Long Fairways Overlooking Hillsborough River are in Shape for Winter Play.

New valleys of pleasure, new heights of delight are open for golfers in Tampa, with the completion of an additional nine holes at Tampa Terraces. This second half of the course, however, will be the out 9, and the half completed last year will be the in-route.

Much credit goes to E. Tuppen, green keeper at Temple Terraces, who, in the last few weeks, has worked wonders with the course. Every green is in shape for play and the fairways have reflected the results of a year's care.

Featuring the new layout, which overlooks the picturesque Hillsborough river, two holes in the nine just completed are calculated to give golfers more pleasure — in case they master them — than the others.

### Two Special Holes

Every hole on the course has been named.

Number 7, a 400-yard par 4, is called the Crall's nest and is copied after a similar one on the famous Gleneagles course in Scotland. Number 9, known also as "Perfection," resembles one on the North Berwick, home course in Scotland of Jimmy Thompson, Temple Terraces professional.

Thompson has just returned from Scotland, where he visited his mother and played several of the best courses, including St. Andrews, which is more than 200 years old. He tells of a controversy in Scotland over the relative merits of Gleneagles and the Pine Valley course of Philadelphia. Thompson has been in Tampa eight consecutive winters, six at Rocky Point and two at Temple Terraces. There was only one course here when he first came and he played the opening game at each of the others.

### The Course in Detail

### Course Is Long One

Total par on each nine is 36, making 72 for the 18 holes. The course is one of the longest in the state, 3,207 yards on the first nine and 3,375 on the second for a total of 6,582 yards.

Fees at Temple Terraces this year will be \$1 a day, \$5 a week or \$15 a month. Bus service will be available daily from the Tampa Bay hotel at 25 cents each way.

Thompson said last night that he expected to arrange numerous exhibition matches and tournaments this winter and would probably bring over some of the best players from Belleair.
